



ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS BACHELOR OF ARTS IN NATIVE AMERICAN STUDIES

Effective 2015-2016 and 2016-2017

Admission Requirements

- Earned 26 credit hours
- Earned a 2.0 cumulative GPA
- Satisfied the English Competence Requirement in one of the following ways:
 - o Completion of ENGL 120 with a grade of C (2.00) or higher
 - o A score of 29 or better on the English portion of the Enhanced ACT
 - o A score of 650 or better on the verbal portion of the SAT
 - o Credits for ENGL 120 through CEEB Advanced Placement Program
 - o Acceptance of the writing proficiency portfolio
- Completion of MATH 102 or higher or ACT=>19 or SAT=>450
- Completion of NATV 150, 250, 251 with a grade of C (2.00) or higher

Basic Requirements for Bachelor of Arts

- Earned total acceptable credit hours = 120
- UNM Core = 37
- Upper Division (300/400 level) credit hours = 42
- Residence Credit:
 - o Minimum hours = 24
 - o In Major = one half (1/2)
 - o In Minor = one quarter (1/4)
- NATV Major Hours = 36
 - o 18 credit hours in Required Core Courses in NATV
 - o 12 credit hours from one of the two concentrations in NATV
 - o 6 credit hours of additional upper division courses in NATV
- A required Minor, hours vary between 18-24 hours
- Minimum GPA in Major = 2.5
- Minimum cumulative GPA = 2.0
- Application for degree at 80 hours

The Core Curriculum applies to all Bachelor degree students – freshmen, transfer, or re-entering the University of New Mexico in Fall 1999 or later. It does not apply to second-degree-seeking students. This checklist reflects Core Curriculum revisions taking effect in fall 2003, and English and Math department course updates as of summer 2014.

Students with transfer credits, CLEP, or AP should meet with an advisor to discuss placement. All students must satisfy the Core Curriculum Requirements with a "C" (not C-). Credit (CR) is acceptable.
