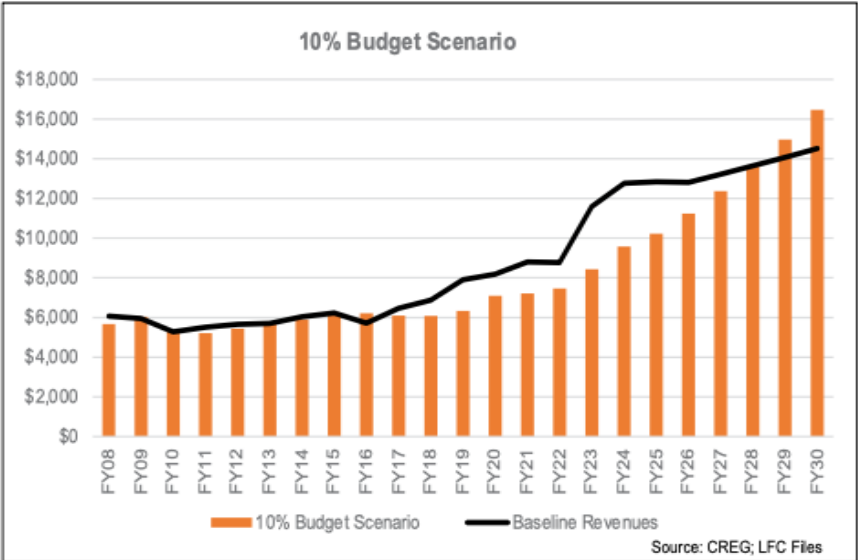
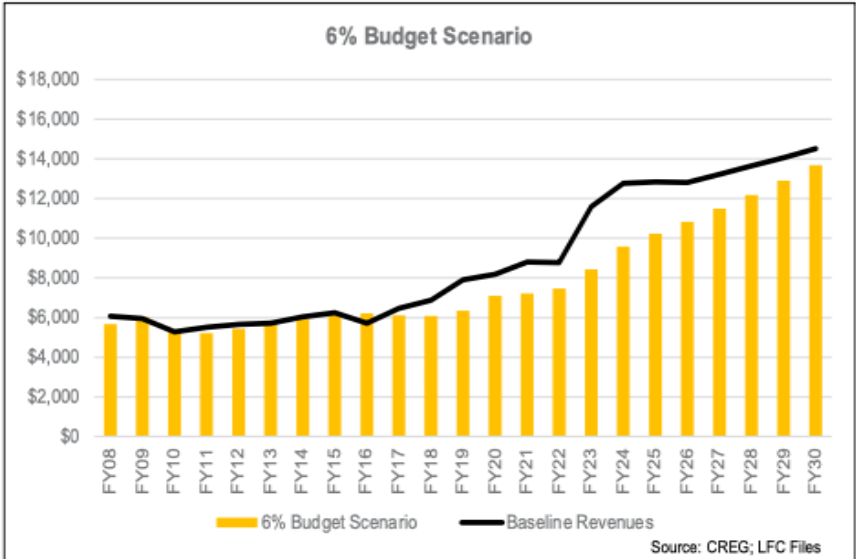
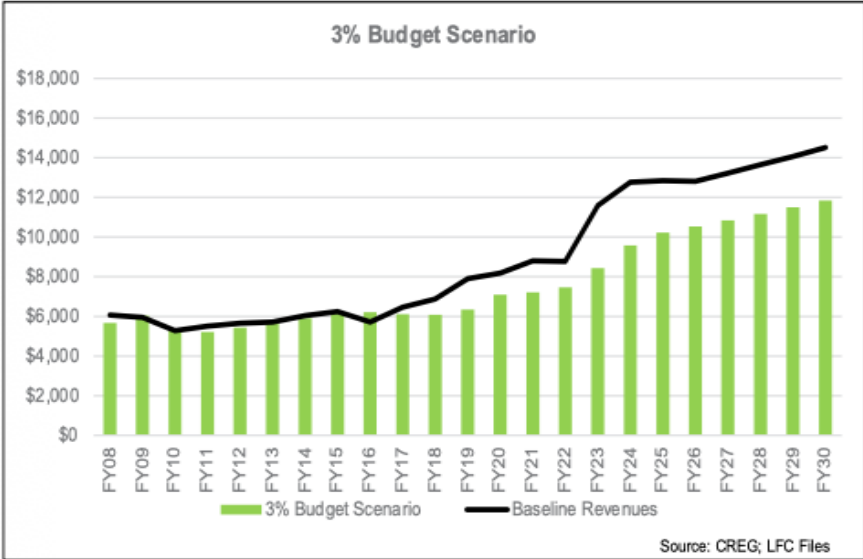

## THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO



### WHAT THEY SEE

- Billions in annual state revenue.
- Structured around extraction.
- Revenue splits into three separate output sources: General Fund, Permanent Fund (Land Grant, Severance Tax), Early Childhood Trust Fund.

### THE DISCONNECT



- State priorities: Revenue, stabilization, economic growth.

- Impacts continue long after revenue is collected.



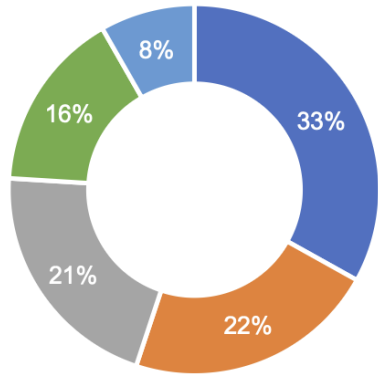
- Indigenous experience: Health, water, land, relationships.

Protecting the places that makes us who we are. IEJ helps make our stories visible and our futures possible.

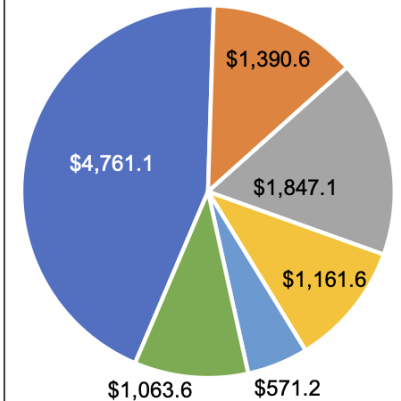
### Estimated FY25 Recurring Revenue Sources
